



## 6.3 Receive Gracefully

### Activity

#### Giving Tree Project

**Prompt:** “We have been learning what the Live to Give Mindset means and how we can live it every day. For this activity, we are going to make a Giving Tree that shows different ways to give to another person or cause using our handprints to make the leaves. By working together and joining hands, we can give back and help each other.”

#### Individual Trees

- Have students use the anchor chart to write ways that they can give on the hand cut-outs.
- Hand out pre-cut tree trunks or give students brown paper to cut theirs out.
- Have students glue their trunk and leaves on the paper.

#### Class Trees

- As a class, paint hands and place them on the pre-painted tree trunk.

For students who need support with writing, create strips of paper that list examples from the anchor chart prior to the lesson. Students can glue the strips on the hand cut-outs.

If completing individual trees, keep the trees for students to share in Live to Give Lesson 6.4.

If completing the class tree, put in a safe place to dry.
