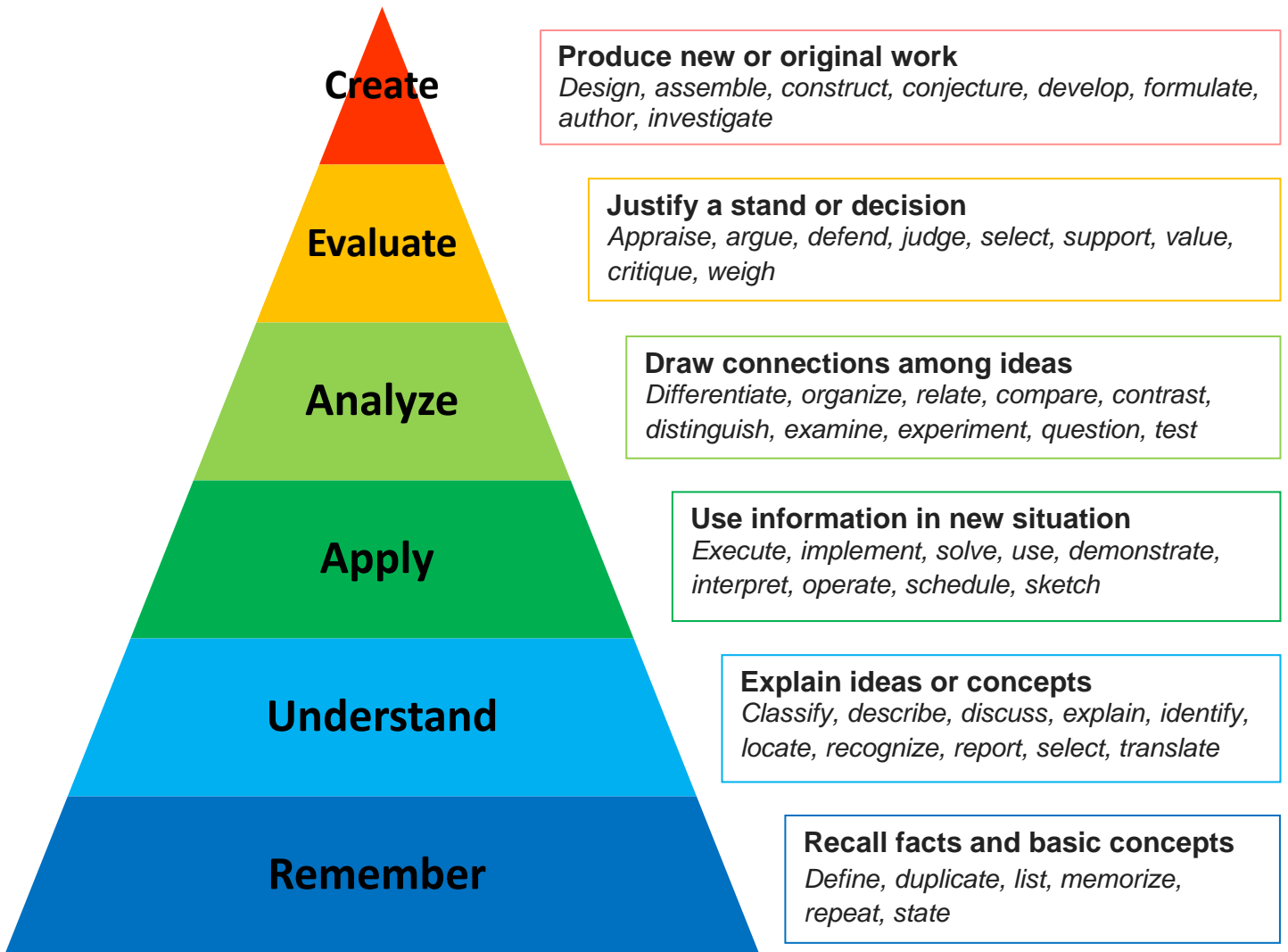


7 Mindsets Curriculum Alignment

The 7 Mindsets curriculum is aligned with Bloom's Taxonomy, developmental research on how students encounter and work with knowledge. In grades K-12, students will be given the opportunity to remember and understand the mindsets and learning objectives. The alignment to Bloom's Taxonomy ensures that your K-12 students completely grasp, understand, and implement the 7 Mindsets to better meet their present challenges and live their ultimate lives.

7 Mindsets Alignment

Remember	Through creative activities, emotionally moving videos and developmentally-appropriate games, students embed the 7 Mindsets and 28 learning objectives deeply in their memories for life-long personal growth.
Understand	Students understand and explain how the 7 Mindsets can be used in every one of their real-life situations to empower them to succeed through mutually-supportive, positive relationships.
Apply	The 7 Mindsets common language is reinforced, consisting of specific, positive, respectful, and encouraging ways of communicating and delivering feedback in support of consistent application of the mindsets in all situations.
Analyze	Through instructor-led discussions and experiments, students recognize the merits of achieving and maintaining happiness and success, and demerits of counter or negative mindsets that dis-empower.
Evaluate	Discussions and developmentally-appropriate games, videos and activities drive students to analyze, explain, and evaluate the key concepts of each mindset.
Create	Students create big dreams, realistic action plans to attain them, and understand how to practice the 7 Mindsets to empower them for success.
